Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

(Tortoise, Hare, and Fox are in the woods.

*Hare is jumping.)* 

Hare: Look at me.

Fox: Well done.

**Tortoise:** What are you doing?

Hare: I am jumping.

Tortoise: Oh!

Hare: Yes. I can jump, and I can run fast.

(Tortoise and Fox watch Hare jumping.)

Hare: Can you jump, Tortoise?

Tortoise: No, I can't.

Hare: Oh.

(Tortoise and Fox watch Hare running.)

**Hare:** Can you run, Tortoise?

Tortoise: No, I can't.

Hare: Oh.

Tortoise: But I can walk.

(Hare smiles.)

Hare: Haha, you can walk!

Tortoise: Yes. I'm a tortoise. I can walk.

Hare: Then we can't have a race.

**Tortoise:** Why not?

**Hare:** You are too slow.

**Tortoise:** Me, too slow? Then let's have a race.

Hare: OK! Let's run from here to the beach.

Tortoise: Great.

(Fox gets his flag ready to start the race.)

Fox: Put your feet here. Three, two, one, GO!

(Hare runs off ahead of Tortoise.)

Fox: Hare is fast . . .

(Hare stops to eat some grass.)

**Hare:** Tortoise is slow. I can eat this nice grass.

(Hare lies down in the sunshine.)

Hare: Now I can sit and enjoy the sun.

Tortoise: Oh. Hare is sleeping!

(Tortoise crosses the finish line.)

Fox: Well done, Tortoise! Where's Hare?

(Hare arrives at the finish line.)

Hare: Oh. You are slow, but you CAN win a race!
