- 5 The wolf looked **up** at them.

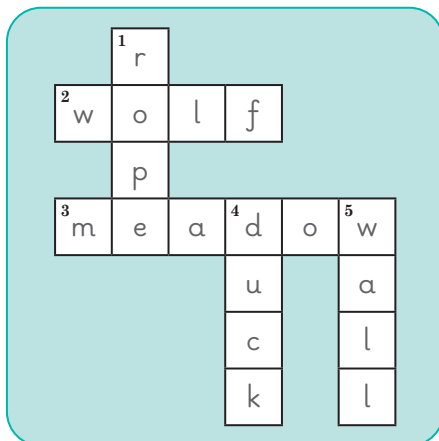
